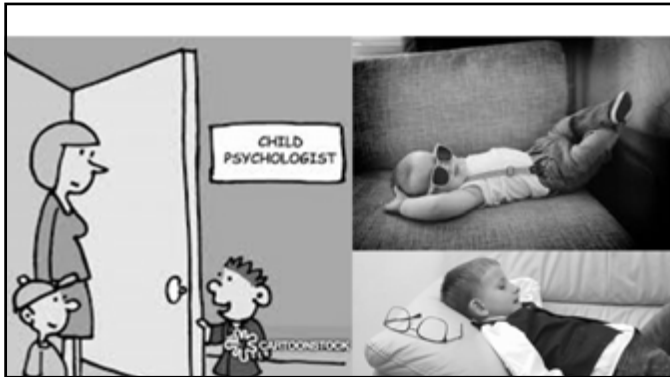

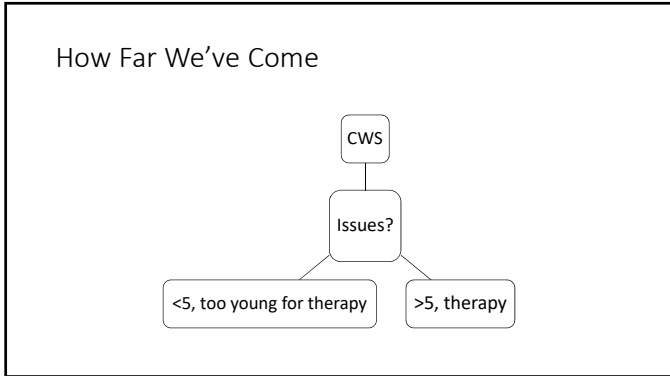
Casey Gwinn takeaways – just a few

- Don’t get hopeless, get MAD! It’s 2nd best

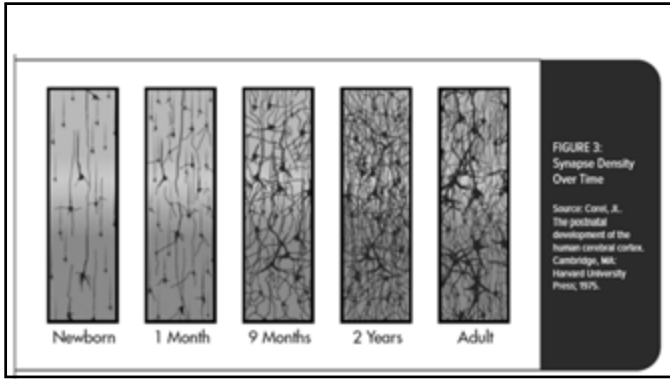

Evolution once the Foundational Science was Established

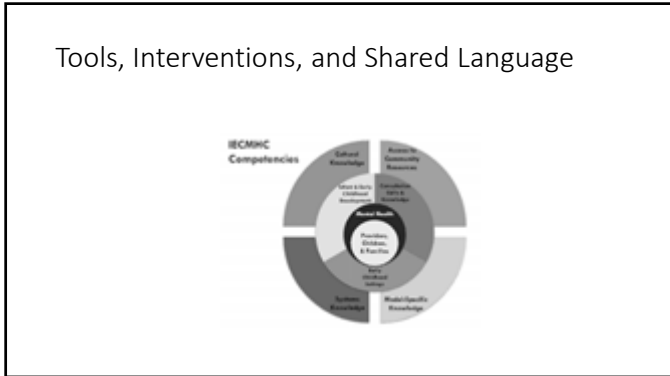
- Tools, Interventions, and Shared Language

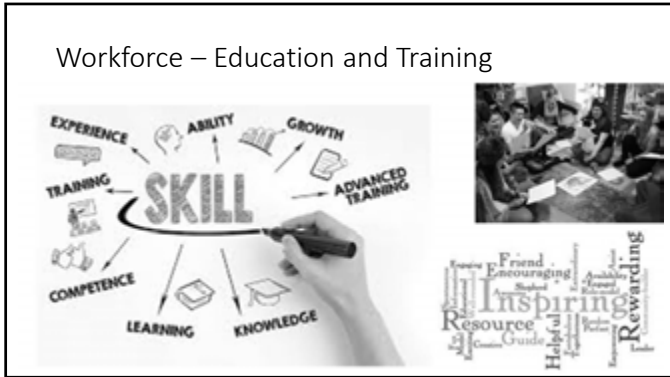
