## H-7- Did Treatments Help?

Sometimes children have received treatments and other interventions before you meet them. Understanding what they received, who did it, and the impact of that intervention can help you with your formulation of the case and also your prioritization of treatments. Examples of treatments and interventions:

- 1. Pediatric care- medical or surgical
- 2. Developmental services like Speech and Language, Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, Behavioral Coaching, Attachment related interventions, ABA therapy, Floor Time interventions
- 3. Psychotherapy- Child Parent Psychotherapy, Parent Child Interaction Therapy, Attachment- Based Therapies
- 4. Psychotropic medication treatments
- Placement in child abuse shelters, foster care, psychiatric hospital
  a. Number of placements matter

b. Ability of adults to successfully transition the child between living environments matter
