Who We Serve:

We serve Kinship caregivers that are raising a family member's child (also those that are not related, but like family). We serve Kinship caregivers that have a child placed by Child Welfare Services (CWS) and those that have no CWS involvement.



- Kinship Navigation
 — Assistance navigating systems and accessing resources to support you in raising a relative's child. Kinship Navigators can help access resources for needs such as:
 - Guardianship & Adoption
 - Public Benefits
 - Childcare & Basic Needs Items
 - Education & Mental Health Services
 - Enrichment activities
- Support Groups—weekly groups providing peer support, training by Grossmont College, childcare, and a light meal
- Family Events—quarterly regional events for networking and fun
- Respite Care—a break or rest for caregivers age 55 and over
