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The Impact of Primary Care Providers Nearly 50% of patients that die by suicide were seen by their PCP within 30 days of their death and 20% saw their PCP within 24 hours of dying from suicide (Luoma, et.al. 2002). 



- · Screens and serves caregivers







Developmental Specialists Partners in Primary Care

- Team-based well-child visits for children birth-5
- Developmental and mental health screening
- Care coordination around recommendations/referrals
- More frequent consultation for behavior and development
- Support for parents, including depression screening and linkage to services

Benefits of Integration



Increased:

- Access
- Early identification
- Connection to services
- Adherence to treatment plans
- Communication and collaboration between providers
- Patient satisfaction
- Physician productivity and satisfaction





- Wait times for services
- Unneeded medical and emergency services when behavioral health problems are adequately addressed
- Stigma

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Integration Models of Care

Collaborative Care

- University-based settings top down model
- Disease-specific approach
- Protocol-driven
- Centered around keeping track of patients via registry and monitoring outcomes
- Psychiatrist-driven
- Manage a large population of patients, but limited flexibility

Primary Care Behavioral Health

- Grass roots setting bottom-up model
- Generalist approach
- Flexible treatment approach
- Centered around Warm Hand Offs
- Care-team driven
- Organized around PCP
- Access/resources can be a challenge

Compare Models, Combine Models

- The unifying similarity between these models is the high level of integration

- Can you combine them?



Developmental Evaluation Clinic (DEC)

- Licensed clinical psychologists with specialized training and experience:
 - Development and early mental health
 - Diagnostic assessment of infants, toddlers, preschool, and school-age children
 - Trauma-informed care
- Serve children birth to 18 yrs (focus on 0-5)

Behavioral Health Integration

Supporting children, caregivers and their primary care providers

- Focus on 0-5
 - HealthySteps in primary care offices (currently Riverside Co.)
 - HDS, KidSTART, DEC
- Support from Integrated Health Therapists in primary care offices (full age range)
- Refer to HUBs if needing prolonged, specialized or more intensive treatment
 - Can see therapist, child psychiatrist or developmental pediatrician and get care coordination services.

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
